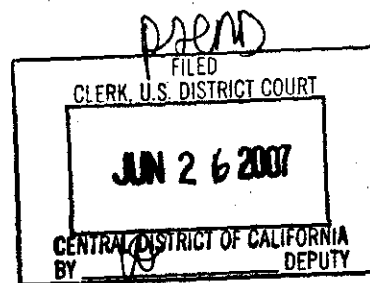

**I. CONSENT TO PROCEED BEFORE A UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE**

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §636(c), the undersigned party or parties to the above-captioned civil matter hereby waive their right to proceed before a District Judge of the United States District Court and consent to have a United States Magistrate Judge conduct any and all further proceedings in the case (including the trial) and order the entry of final judgment.

**II. DESIGNATION/ASSIGNMENT OF A UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE**

*In accordance with Local Rule 73-2, the parties may stipulate to the designation of a specific Magistrate Judge to conduct all further proceedings unless a particular Magistrate Judge has already been assigned to the case under General Order 05-07, in which event the case shall remain with that Magistrate Judge. Please consult the Court's website at [www.cacd.uscourts.gov](http://www.cacd.uscourts.gov) ("Civil Consent Cases" under the section entitled "General Information") for a list of all Magistrate Judges currently available for consent cases.*

The undersigned party or parties hereby stipulate to the designation of Magistrate Judge Hon. Marc L. Goldman to conduct any and all further proceedings in this case.

**III. APPELLATE REVIEW**

Any appeal from a judgment of the Magistrate Judge shall be taken to the United States Court of Appeals in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of the District Judge in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §636(c)(3).

**IV. NOTICE TO COURT REGARDING DATE OF FILING**



Pursuant to Local Rule 73-4, unless the consent is filed at least thirty (30) before the date of the final pretrial conference, it will require the approval of the District Judge.

CONSENT TO PROCEED BEFORE A UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE

- Less than thirty (30) days before the date of the final pretrial conference. Therefore, the approval of the District Judge is required.


